

SPECIAL ELECTION

Bath County, VA

Tuesday, December 18, 2018

There will be a Special Election in Bath County, VA for the Virginia House of Delegates, 24th District. All regular polling locations will be open. In order to be qualified to vote in the Special Election on Tuesday, December 18, 2018, your registration **must be received in this office** no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 11, 2018. The Constitution of Virginia requires that you be registered in the precinct in which you live in order to be qualified to vote. December 11 is also the deadline to file a change of address.

IMPORTANT DEADLINES:

Last Day to Register or Change Address: **December 11, 2018**

Last Day to Request Absentee Ballot by Mail: **December 11, 2018**

Last Day to Vote In-Person Absentee: **December 15, 2018**

Voters may apply to receive absentee ballots by mail now. In-person absentee voting will begin on or about November 27, as soon as ballots arrive. Please call the office for more information. The Voter Registration Office for Bath County is located on the first floor of the Bath County Courthouse in Warm Springs. The office is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to noon and 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm.

The Voter Registration Office will be open on Saturday December 15 from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm for the convenience of registered voters who need to vote an absentee ballot for this election.

ADA compliant voting equipment is available in the Registrar's office for in-person absentee voting and in all polling places on Election Day.
