

BATH COUNTY, VA BEGINS NEW REASSESSMENT

Bath County, VA – The Bath County Board of Supervisors has hired the firm of Wampler – Eanes Appraisal Group, Ltd. to conduct the reassessment of real property in Bath County. Wampler – Eanes Appraisal Group, Ltd. conducted the last reassessment effective January 1, 2011. This firm was established in 1996 and is located in Daleville. They specialize in equalization assessments. The firm will begin field work in the County starting July 1, 2015. Visits to individual properties will continue throughout the year.

The purpose of the reassessment is to reflect 100 percent market value, as required by State law, and to obtain uniformity, assuring that properties of similar type and value carry similar assessments.
